From Monday, October 9th at 7am until Friday, October 13th at 4pm, the Pennsauken Police Department will post no parking along either side of Holman Ave. from Union Ave. to June Road

PSE&G's crews will be reconstructing Holman Ave. curb to curb from Union Ave. to June Road. Construction hours will be Monday to Saturday, from 7am until 4pm. Please do not park along Holman Ave. during this time period.

During this construction period, the Pennsauken Police Department will provide traffic control and assure you can safely enter and exit your driveways and homes.

All work will be performed and supervised by PSE&G. The crews will adhere to all PSE&G safety and environmental standards and procedures, and work diligently with the Pennsauken Township Police Department to minimize traffic disruption. We will do everything feasible to complete our work expeditiously while maintaining the highest levels of safety for all involved or impacted by the project. There are no planned power interruptions during this time period.

At PSE&G, safety is number one. Only trained and qualified contractors and employees are permitted to work on PSE&G construction sites. A supervisor and trained safety watchers will be on the site during all construction activities. We respectfully ask that you NOT enter the construction area.
