SHOTGUN STARTS

- Shotgun starts are available to groups with a **minimum of 100 players** (140 maximum) on **Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.**
- Shotgun starts are available to groups with a **minimum of 120 players** (140 maximum) on **Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.**
- Shotgun starting times will be as follows:
 - Morning events may begin at 9:00 AM.
 - Monday through Friday afternoon events may choose a starting time between 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM.
 - Saturday and Sunday afternoon events may begin at 1:00 PM.
 - Double shotguns must have a minimum of 200 players between morning and afternoon sessions.**

CONSECUTIVE STARTING TIMES

- Consecutive starting times are offered for groups not utilizing a shotgun start format.
- For consecutive tee time prices, please note enclosed rate schedule.
- Consecutive starting times will begin as follows:

Monday through Friday: Anytime
Saturday, Sunday & Holidays: 12:00 pm or later

DEPOSIT & FULL PAYMENT

Groups may be asked to remit a **\$500.00** deposit at time of reservation. Guaranteed guest count will be required seven days prior to the event with no cancellations or refunds after that date. Deposit and full payment may be in the form of a bank or company check, cash or credit card. **All credit Cards will be charged an additional 5% convenience fee.** Please make checks payable to **Pennsauken Country Club.**

Pennsauken Country Club and Marco's Restaurant are separate entities and will require separate reservations & payments.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Our concessionaire, *Marco's Restaurant*, is a full service restaurant and catering facility. Award winning cuisine and breathtaking golf course views are all part of your dining experience. Any size golf outing, business meeting or private party can be accommodated. *Please contact their catering office at 856-438-5283 for any food & beverage requirements including menus, information and reservations.*

No person or group may bring any outside food or beverage for a tournament without express permission from Catering by Marco's at Pennsauken Country Club.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Alcoholic beverages are served in the restaurant and lounge.

The New Jersey Liquor Control Board licenses us and their regulations prohibit customers from bringing alcoholic beverages onto the property.

RULES & REGULATIONS

The rules and regulations of the Pennsauken Country Club are designed to create a safe and enjoyable golfing experience for all participants

Tournament coordinators are responsible for informing all participants of the rules and regulations of the facility.

GOLF CARTS

All tournament players are required to use golf carts. Tournament officials, volunteers, witnesses and photographers may be permitted to use golf carts to perform their duties during the tournament with permission from the pro shop staff. *Spectators are not permitted on the golf course.*

Careless golf cart usage will not be tolerated. The tournament coordinator will be responsible for any damage to golf carts or damage by golf carts caused by their tournament players or volunteers

SLOW PLAY & MARSHALING

Please make your participants aware that the *pace of play is relevant to the group in front of them, not the group behind them*, in order to insure a most enjoyable day for all. *Pace of play and golf cart usage will be closely monitored by our marshals.*

DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT

The tournament coordinator will be responsible to provide:

1. List of players in foursomes for the Pro Shop, with their scheduled tee times. (*Shotgun starts must provide a list of players in foursomes with their hole assignments three days before the event.*)
2. Witnesses and /or volunteers to set up and remove sponsor signs. *Any signs not removed immediately following the event will be discarded.*

Pennsauken Country Club will provide upon request:

1. Registration area including table(s), tablecloth(s), and chair(s).
2. Bag Drop area, if requested, staffed by your personnel.
3. Golf cart for volunteers to set up sponsor signs on tee boxes before the event and for removal immediately after the event.
4. Scorecards, pencils, & score sheets. (Available prior to tournament date for early set up.)
5. Contest markers and tape measures for Longest Drive, Closest to Pin holes, etc.
6. Announcement system to welcome guests and announce tournament rules.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Pennsauken Country Club does not require any player or group to play at their reserved time if inclement weather is present or the possibility of severe weather exists.

If the golf course superintendent or a group decides to cancel play before the start of the tournament, *due to inclement weather only*, all monies will be returned. If a rain date is selected, the deposit will be retained for the new date. It is at the discretion of the golf course superintendent (if necessary) and/or the tournament coordinator as to whether the group will begin play. If play begins, the event will be billed only for those who actually played. *Absolutely no rain checks will be given once play has begun.*

Please be advised these weather policies are for the golf course only. Any changes in food & beverage reservations will first need to be discussed with Marco's Restaurant at Pennsauken Country Club.

FROST

There is always the possibility of frost during the cooler months. All starting times may be delayed if there is a frost delay on the day of the tournament.

PRO SHOP

The Pro Shop is fully stocked with a wide variety of apparel for tournament prizes & gifts. Gift cards are also available.

RULES and REGULATIONS for 2021

- 1) **Proper attire** is greatly appreciated by the management. **For all players**, permissible footwear will include **NON - METAL / PENETRATING or SPIKELESS** golf shoes or sneakers.
- 2) Rain checks will be not be granted if inclement weather has been forecasted or is imminent.
- 3) All golf members are required to sign in prior to beginning play.
- 4) All daily fee customers are required to register in the pro shop prior to beginning play.
- 5) All players must register with the starter prior to beginning play.
- 6) All daily fee customers must retain their receipts until their round has been completed.
- 7) All players must begin play on the first tee unless permission has been received from the pro shop staff and or starter or unless there is an alternate starting point designated by the pro shop staff.
- 8) Absolutely no more than four (4) players per group will be permitted unless authorized by the pro shop staff.
- 9) All players are expected to be aware of The USGA Pace of Play Rating noted on the scorecard. Accordingly, all players are expected to complete their round within this established timeframe.
- 10) All groups must keep their position on the course behind the group in front of them, not in front of the group behind them.
- 11) Slow groups falling behind by more than the one hole spacing provided at the beginning of their round will be asked to pick up the pace of play and thereafter, will be asked to pick up their balls and move forward to the correct position.
- 12) Alcohol is prohibited from being stored in any locker that is the property of the facility.
- 13) No coolers will be permitted on the golf course.
- 14) Each player must have their own set of clubs and golf bag. Players are not permitted to share a set for any reason.
- 15) Abuse to the golf course will not be tolerated for any reason. Any player found to be inflicting abuse will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- 16) Flagrant language directed at an employee or customer will not be tolerated for any reason.
- 17) The **infliction of physical harm** against any customer of the facility is **FORBIDDEN !** Should this occur, said individuals will be asked to depart the premises immediately and if needed, the local authorities will be notified.
- 18) All players must be considerate of their surroundings during the course of their round.
- 19) A maximum of two players and two golf bags will be permitted for those players renting motorized golf carts.
- 20) Individuals who rent a motorized golf cart as a single are not permitted to give rides to those players who are walking.
- 21) Motorized golf carts must be kept outside all areas designated by directional signage, rail fencing and or ropes.
- 22) Motorized golf carts should be kept on the cart paths when in the area of any and all teeing grounds.
- 23) Motorized golf carts must be returned upon completion of the holes paid for unless additional rental fees have been paid.
- 24) Hand carts are prohibited from being pulled onto the apron of any putting green.
- 25) Starting times are required by all players using the facility unless a player is a single.
- 26) All players not part of a group (singles) must report to the starter in order to be paired with players waiting to begin play.
- 27) Any player(s) and or groups of players found to be **abusing the privilege of making advance starting time reservations** will be reprimanded in the following manner:
 - a) **verbal warning given.**
 - b) **written warning forwarded to offender(s).**
 - c) **loss of starting time reservation privilege for the player(s) and or group(s).**
- 28) The starter has full authority as to the order of tee off with regard to reserved starting times.
- 29) It is better to have a starting time reservation and cancel it rather than expecting to be squeezed in if a group does not have a starting time.
- 30) All groups with reserved starting times must be present and check in with the starter at least fifteen (15) minutes prior.
- 31) Any group late for their designated starting time will be placed in the next available opening on the starting time sheet.
- 32) Please repair all ball marks, replace all divots and rake all bunkers caused and or used during the course of a round.
- 33) Please wave up the group behind on hole number 7.
- 34) Please deposit all litter in the appropriate receptacles located throughout the golf course.
- 35) In the event of a disturbing situation, please contact an employee of the facility immediately.
- 36) **Golf membership refund requests will be reviewed for extreme medical situations only. If granted, the balance of a member's golf membership, based on the date of receipt of a refund request letter, will be carried over to the ensuing year. The Board of Directors of the facility will have final say as to whether a refund is approved.**
- 37) **ABSOLUTELY NO NON-PLAYING SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED.**
- 38) **ALL PLAYERS MUST MAKE USE OF THE TUNNEL UNDER HADDONFIELD ROAD THAT HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL CUSTOMERS.**
