The applicant proposes to have stores facing Route 38. This application will be heard at the Zoning Board in September.

<u>Ceron Development,</u> (Felix Ceron) 5341 Kaighn Avenue, Block 6001, Lot 52, Zoning District: C-2.

The applicant proposes a Mexican bakery, restaurant and grocery store at the location of the former Berschler Funeral Home on Route 38. There is an existing 8,000 sq. ft. building. The applicant also proposes to add a laundromat.
