RESOLUTION ADOPTING A NOTICE OF TORT CLAIM FORM

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Tort Claims Act, N.J.S.A. 59:1-1, *et seq.* defines a public entity's liabilities and immunities for allegations of tortious conduct; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Tort Claims Act, N.J.S.A. 59:8-6, provides that a public entity may adopt a form to be completed by claimants seeking to file a Notice of Tort Claim against the public entity; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Pennsauken ("Township") is a public entity covered by the provisions of the New Jersey Tort Claims Act; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsauken has determined it is prudent, necessary, and in the public interest to adopt a Notice of Tort Claim Form in the form attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsauken, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that all persons making claims against the Township of Pennsauken pursuant to the New Jersey Tort Claims Act, N.J.S.A. 59:1-1, *et seq.* must complete the form herein adopted for compliance with the notice requirements of the New Jersey Tort Claims Act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Notice of Tort Claim Form adopted herein shall be effective immediately.
