

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A WINDOW CONTRACT FOR
2022 CHEVY COLORADO TRUCK
(BARLOW CHEVROLET)**

Whereas, the Township of Pennsauken has determined that there is a need for a new pickup truck to service the Department of Public Works' needs in the Township of Pennsauken; and

Whereas, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3 states that a contract, the cost of which will not exceed \$44,000 in a fiscal year, shall be awarded without public advertising for bids and bidding therefore, but N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6.1 provides that prior to the award of said contract, the municipality shall solicit quotations whenever practicable for a contract, the estimated cost of which is fifteen percent or more of the bid threshold, and award the contract to the entity who submitted the most advantageous quotation price and other factors considered; and

Whereas, the Director of Public Works obtained three quotes for the new pickup truck with Barlow Chevrolet, 6057 Route 130 South, Delran, New Jersey 08075 in the amount of \$36,135 being the lowest responsible quote; and

Whereas, the Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Pennsauken, as required by N.J.A.C. 5:30-1, has certified that there are sufficient funds available for the purpose of awarding a contract to said entity, to encumber funds against budget account C-04-22-100-202.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsauken, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Township Committee for the aforementioned reasons, hereby declares that Barlow Chevrolet, 6057 Route 130 South, Delran, New Jersey 08075, submitted a quotation and hereby awards a contract to said entity for the aforesaid product in an amount not to exceed \$36,135.
2. Barlow Chevrolet has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Barlow Chevrolet has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Pennsauken in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit Barlow Chevrolet from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract.
3. The Township Committee hereby directs the Township Administrator and the Township Clerk to execute any contract documents which are necessary to effectuate the terms of this resolution, subject to review, revision and approval by the Township Solicitor.
4. That the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value to be placed on file with this resolution.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
