THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSAUKEN RESOLUTION NO. 2024:218

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSAUKEN, IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, NEW JERSEY, REJECTING ALL OF THE SECOND ROUND BIDS AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO NEGOTIATE THE CONTRACT WITH RESPONSIBLE BIDDERS FOR THE L.E.D. LIGHTING RETROFIT ON EXISTING POLES AT ATHLETIC FIELDS PROJECT

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the Township of Pennsauken (the "Township") has previously authorized the L.E.D. Lighting Retrofit on Existing Poles at Athletic Fields Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Township first advertised for bids for the Project pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, on April 30th, 2024, two (2) bids were received in response to the first advertisement; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid, submitted by Applied Landscape Technologies, in the total amount of \$787,665.00, substantially exceeded the cost estimate of the Project, which the Township estimated at \$126,250 and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2024:195, all bids were determined to substantially exceed the cost estimate of the Project, and were consequently rejected consistent with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2(a); and

WHEREAS, the Township advertised a second time for bids for the Project pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, *et seq.*, with the same Scope of Work and Specifications; and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2024, two (2) bids were received in response to the second advertisement; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the lowest bid submitted by Applied Landscape Technologies in the total amount of \$773,760.00 substantially exceeds the cost estimate of the Project, which the Township estimated at \$126,250 and therefore the Township intends to again reject all bids pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2(a); and

WHEREAS, the Township has twice solicited bids for the Project, and both attempts to secure a reasonable price to perform the required work through the public bidding process resulted in bids substantially in excess of the Township's estimate for performing such work; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-5(3), the Township is authorized to negotiate with the bidders in an effort to reach an agreement to construct the Project for an amount that would more closely meet the Township's cost projection, but in no event more than the \$773,760.00 bid by Applied Landscape; and

WHEREAS, the Township shall notify previous bidders of its intention to negotiate, pursuant to and consistent with <u>N.J.S.A</u>. 40A:11-5(3).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSAUKEN, IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The Township hereby rejects all bids as substantially exceeding the estimated cost for the Project, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:13.2(a).
- Section 2. The Township authorizes the negotiation and execution of a contract for the Project pursuant to and consistent with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(3).

<u>Section 3.</u> The award of any contract pursuant to said negotiations shall only become effective upon approval and adoption of a Resolution of two-thirds affirmative vote of the authorized membership of the Township.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption this 6^{TH} day of June 2024.
