RESOLUTION REQUIRING CLAIMANT CERTIFICATIONS ON CERTAIN TYPES OF TRANSACTIONS

WHEREAS, N.J. S. A. 40A: 5-16(a) restricts payment to vendors

without completed Claimant certifications on purchase orders, a Claimant or

Vendor certification is a certification from the party claiming payment that the bill

or demand is correct; and

WHEREAS, Local Finance Notice 2018- 13 adopted new regulations on

Claimant Certifications, allowing greater flexibility for local units in implementing

the claimant certification requirement set forth in N. J. S. A. 40A: 5-16(a); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Pennsauken desires to eliminate the

requirement for claimant certifications for all vendors with the following

exception, the advance or reimbursement of employee expenses, or for

services provided exclusively and entirely by an individual, including sole

proprietors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of

the Township of Pennsauken, in the County of Camden and State of New

Jersey to eliminate the requirement for vendor signature on Township purchase

orders except for the advance or reimbursement of employee expenses, or for

services provided exclusively and entirely by an individual, including sole

proprietors.
